

Stage 1 - ARPEL Process

ARPEL Registration Process :

- Register for the ARPEL Process and make sure to confirm the eligibility. Registration link: <https://forms.office.com/r/Tgb1bYBDQr>
- After registration, an email will be sent to the applicant containing the ARPEL Process Guidelines and link to pay the fee of Eur197 (VAT is included).
- Following payment, the applicant will receive the detailed ARPEL Process form to be filled in.
- Send the relevant documents in English Language and in PDF format with the requested file name.
- Confirm the availability for the interview. Make sure to be on time for this interview.
- Respond to the final results and submit any concerns/appeals to admin@aea.academy
- Join the Stages 2 & 3 in sequence and earn the Level 5 - Undergraduate Higher Diploma in Social Entrepreneurship at 90 ECTS credits!

What is the ARPEL process?

The ARPEL process is for applicants with suitable experience and recognises the experiences and prior learning of such participants ensuring the recognition and accreditation with ECTS credits at EQF/MQF Level 5 for such learning and work experiences. This process involves data collection, organisation, evaluation, and validation of student learning and experience profiles to obtain Accreditation & Recognition of Prior Experiences & Learning in the field of commercial or social entrepreneurship.

What is the Eligibility to apply for ARPEL?

The ARPEL participant must satisfy the following minimum qualification and experience requirements:

- A minimum of 2 years work experience in an SME environment
- IELTS Level 5 / English Language Proficiency Certificate

What are the details requested in the ARPEL application form?

The participants need to fill the details of Formal, Informal, Non-formal Learning experiences and Work experience (at least 2 years of experience in an SME or NGO environment).

After submitting the application the following documents need to be sent to the institution **in pdf format and in English language**.

- An updated CV in Euro pass format
- The support documents/proofs for Formal Learning, Informal Learning, Non-Formal Learning and Prior Work Experience. This can include educational certificates, proofs of achievements or attendance and work experience certificate from the organisations.

These documents need to be sent to the email address admin@aea.academy

Is there any interview in the ARPEL process?

The participants are requested to attend an evaluation interview with the Evaluator of the ARPEL process. The interview will be of maximum 50 minutes duration. The interview plan will be sent via email.
