## Project objectives

EntrePubl aims to develop training pathways to enable public servants to view their role differently and approach challenges with an entrepreneurial mindset. This will help them collaborate more effectively and improve efficiency. The project also focuses on implementing digital solutions within public institutions. To achieve this, VET trainers and providers will be engaged to design an educational package that meets the needs of public sector employees and helps them develop digital skills for entrepreneurial learning. VET educators and public institution trainers will offer the training.

The project will use the [EntreComp](#) and [DigComp](#) frameworks to identify the essential entrepreneurial and digital skills that public sector employees need. This will help them develop new capabilities and digital skills and create value for their institution and the public.

- Promote the use of **flexible online training** by VET trainers.

The next phase of our implementation involves developing a comprehensive course on the eight core competences including Creativity, Ethical and sustainable thinking, Self-awareness and self-efficacy, Taking the initiative, Working with others, Mobilising resources, Financial Literacy, and Information and data literacy. Our team is currently working diligently to develop engaging and informative course material that will help learners to develop and improve these essential competences. Through this course, we aim to equip learners with the knowledge and skills they need to successfully navigate the challenges of entrepreneurship, create value, and contribute positively to society.

## Approbation – Training activity for VET trainers

We are excited to announce that the Approbation Training for VET trainers is scheduled to take place from 13th-15th June 2023 in the beautiful city of Bologna, Italy. The training will span over a period of three days and will host a total of eighteen trainers from six countries. The primary objective of the training is to equip VET trainers with the knowledge and skills they need to effectively implement the EntrePubl methodology and modules. Through interactive workshops and practical training sessions, participants will learn the intricacies of the methodology and develop their teaching skills to improve the learning outcomes of their students.
